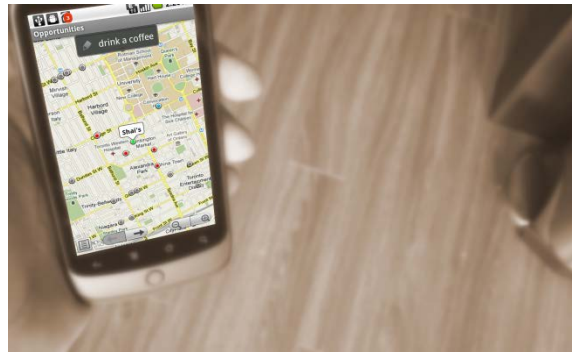


Opportunities Exist Storyboard

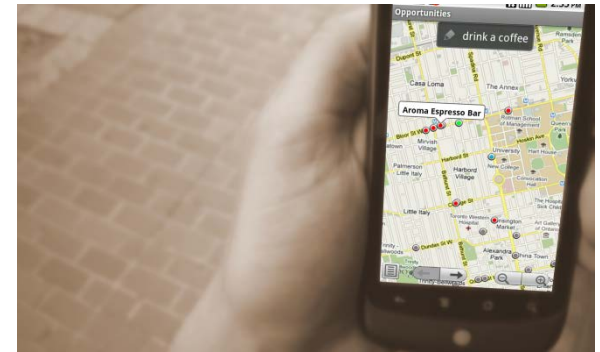

Ivana gets out of the cab and checks OE.

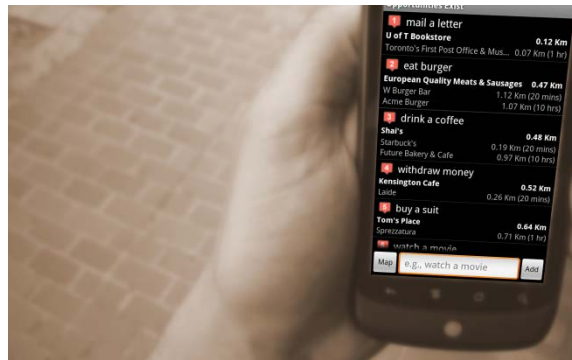
She sees that Aroma Espresso Bar is near.

Traffic was light this morning so she has 5 minutes to spare. Ivana decides that is enough time to get a quick espresso.



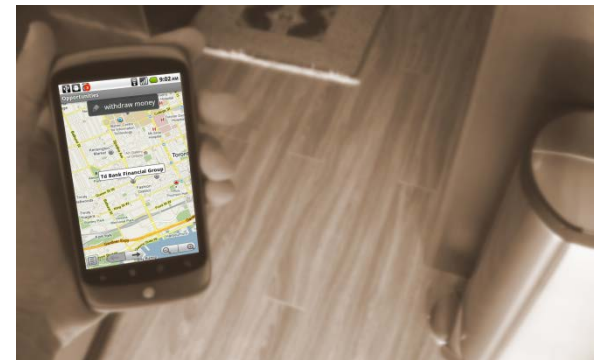
Paying for the espresso, Ivana notices that she is running low on cash. So she puts 'withdraw money' into OE.
