## PhD Conference Travel Grant Application

PURPOSE: The PhD Conference Travel Grant provides modest reimbursement to eligible students who will be actively presenting their research at an academic conference.

VALUE: The amount reimbursed is dependent on the number of eligible applications each cycle, with a maximum of \$500 (Quebec & Ontario), \$800 (North America), \$1000 (overseas).

ELIGIBILITY: Applicants must be full-time registered PhD students, in good standing, presenting a research related paper, poster or speaking at a conference, approved by their supervisor.

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION: 15 October for travel between 1 July and 31 December, and 1 February for travel between 1 January and 30 June.
